Submission Guidelines

- Abstract Submissions: Up to 250 words; up to 5 keywords; maximum 12–15 minutes presentation slot requested.
- Authors may submit full-length papers of up to 5000 words as per the respective track guidelines. The template provided at the later stage of submission.
- Poster Submissions: Poster (portrait) with clear sections: title, authors, affiliations, abstract, key results.
- Review Paper submission that provides a comprehensive overview of a specific research area by summarizing and synthesizing existing literature.
- Case Study submission that presents practical experiences, often in industry settings, which provide insights or lessons for the research community.
- Language: English (all submissions except Education and Arts).
- Plagiarism report: Required for AI-related research upto 20% & 10% Plagiarism.
- Ethical statement/disclosure: Includes disclosure of data usage, consent, and governance considerations.
- Templates: Use the provided templates for abstracts, full papers, and posters (attached with the brochure package or available on the conference site).

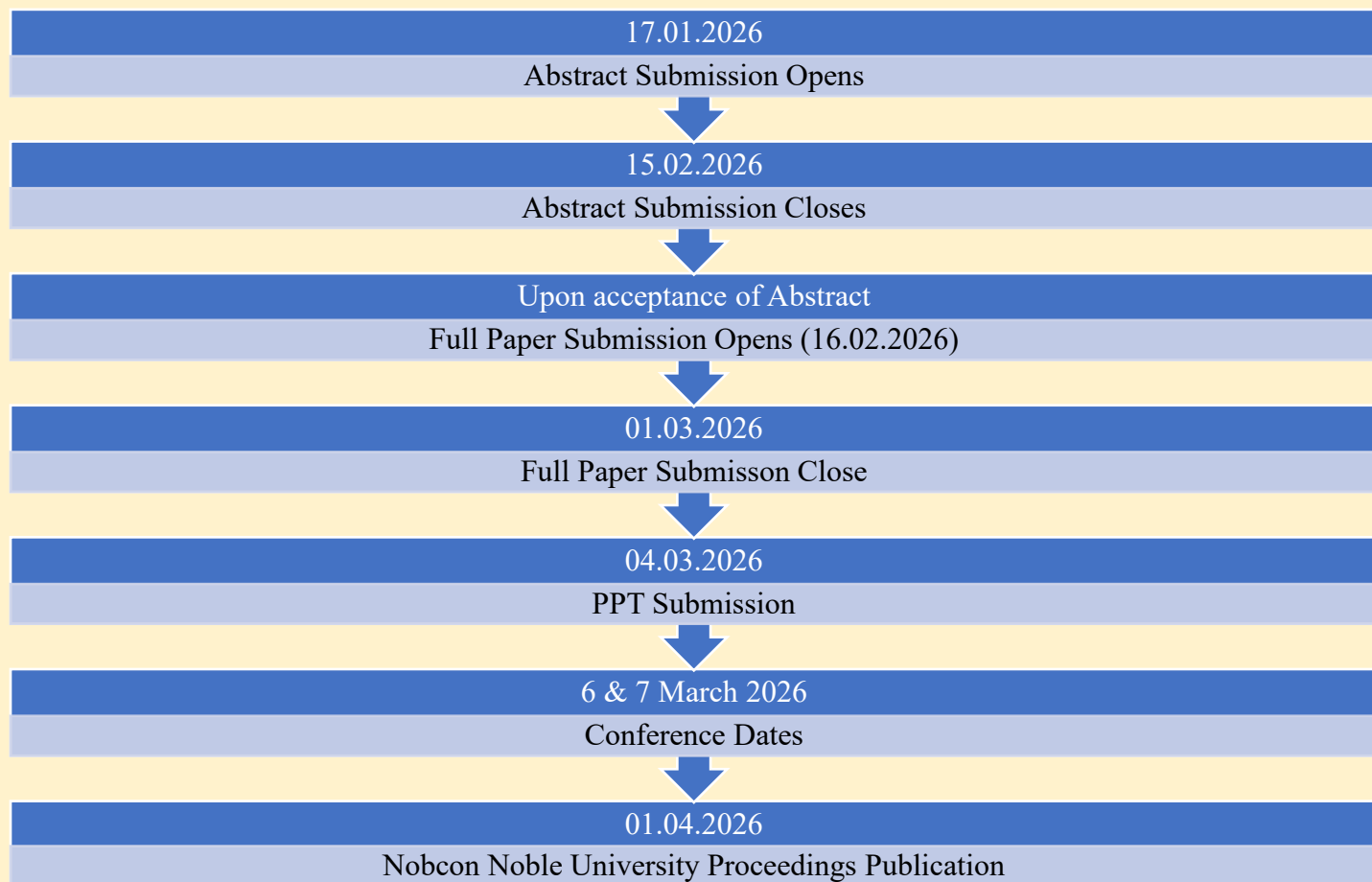
