RESTORATION ORDER

Whereas, recognition was granted to the institution, namely, 2014 Shri Vivek Bharti Trust B.Ed. College, Parth Vatika, Junagadh, Bhesan Highway, Bamangam, Junagadh, Gujarat -362310 under section 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students vide order no. WRC/5-6/101/2008/ C-28203-209 dated 31.01.2008.

2. And whereas, after the promulgation of NCTE (Recognition, Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 vide notification dt. 28.11.2014 the 2014 Shri Vivek Bharti Trust B.Ed. College, Parth Vatika, Junagadh, Bhesan Highway, Bamangam, Junagadh, Gujarat -362310 offering B.Ed. course was informed via email/public notice to submit a duly notarized affidavit as an acceptance of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the institution.

3. And whereas, after the receipt of affidavit dt. 12.01.2015 from the institution, a revised recognition order no. WRC/APW05182/323509/B.Ed.(Revised Order) /2015/144949 dt. 31.05.2015 was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students) from the session 2015-16.

4. And Whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its 255th Meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided to issue show cause notice dt. 25.09.2017 to the institution.

5. And Whereas, reply dt. 13.10.2017 of institution was placed before the WRC in its 293rd meeting held on June 12th - 14th, 2018 and Committee decided as follows:-

"The case file was seen. Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice 25.09.2017 was issued and the institute replied on 13.10.2017.

The institute has not submitted fresh staff profile after regulations, 2014. The institute has also not submitted Additional FDRs for 4 Lakhs and Building Completion Certificate from a Govt. Engineer.

Hence, Recognition is withdrawn from the session 2018-19.

FDRs, if any, be returned."

6. And Whereas, a withdrawal order no WRC/05182/323509/Guj./293rd/ 2018/198707 dt. 22.06.2018 was issued to the institution.

7. And Whereas, the institution had filed an appeal at NCTE Hqrs. New Delhi and the Appellant Authority vide order dt. 12.09.2018 has decided as follows:-

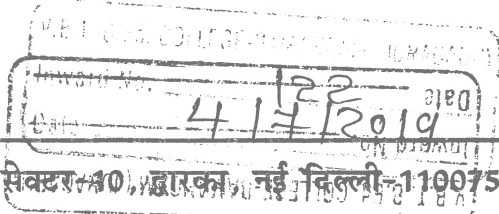
"Appellant institution is required to submit complete list along with all supporting documents submitted by them in appeal to the Regional Committee within 15 days of the issue of appeal order. Appeal committee decided to remand back the case to W.R.C for revisiting the matter after the appellant institution submits required documents and taking further action expeditiously.

After perusal of the memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the committee concluded that the matter deserved to be remanded to the W.R.C. for revisiting the matter, after the appellant institution submits required documents and taking further action expeditiously.

The council hereby remands back the case of Shri Vivek Bharti Trust B.Ed. College, Parth Vatika, Near Bamangam, Bheemsan Road, Junagarh, Gujarat to the WRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above."

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8. And Whereas, reply dt. 23.08.2018 of institution was placed before the WRC in its 297th meeting held on September 13th – 14th, 2018, and Committee decided as follows:-

"The case file was seen. Recognition was withdrawn vide order dated 22.06.2018. Thereafter the institution went in appeal and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 17.09.2018 remanded the case to WRC for revisiting the documents to be submitted by the institution. The institution vide letter dated 23.08.2018 submitted a staff profile of 1+18 faculty members, Building Completion Certificate from a Government Engineer.

An examination of the file shows that the lecturers at S.No.6, 9-13 and 17-19 do not have the NET qualification as required by the NCTE notification published on 09.06.2017. As such, the institution is eligible for one unit. If the institution requires two units, they must fulfill the requirement as per Appendix-IV of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per notification published on 09.06.2017. The institution should submit staff profile approved by the Registrar signed on every page.

Hence, Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution. Reply should be submitted within one month, failing which recognition will be withdrawn."

9. And Whereas, show cause notice No. WRC WRC/APW05182/323509/297th/ B.Ed./Guj./2018/200072 dt. 18.09.2018 was issued to the institution.

10. And whereas, reply dt. 18.09.2018, 10.10.2018, 11.04.2019, 16.04.2019 & 11.04.2019 of the institution was placed before the WRC in its 308th meeting held on June 19th-21st, 2019 and the Committee decided as follows :-

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 18/09/2018 and reply received on 25/09/2018. The committee considered the reply and found that qualified staff is adequate only for one unit.

Hence, the committee decided to restore the recognition for B.Ed. course for one unit (50 students)."

11. Now Therefore, the recognition granted to the institution for conducting B.Ed. course has been restored as per decision of the WRC in its 308th meeting and Institution is permitted to continue the existing B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 seats (one basic unit of 50 students).

12. It is also informed that the institution shall continue to follow the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and any deviation from it will be liable for action, against the institution, as defined under NCTE Act, 1993 and NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Revised order no. WRC/APW05182/323509/B.Ed. (Revised Order) /2015/144949 dt. 31.05.2015 be treated as cancelled from the date of issue of this order.
